Are you being PROACTIVE for REACH? REACH entered into force on June 1, 2007. Seven substances from the candidate list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) are recommended for the Authorization process. Meanwhile candidate SVHC disclosure requirements are in full effect, 38 SVHCs have been identified, the Commission expects 135 to be on the list by 2012, and NGOs have identified 365 potential SVHCs.
